2026 TEAM EVALUATIONS

Athletes trying out are encouraged to attend team workout sessions (March 31-April 21, 2026) before evaluations. Contact the front desk for registration and pricing information.

Beginning April 1, 2026 athletes will sign up for a private evaluation time to demonstrate jumps, tumbling and flying ability (if applicable). Evaluations are held April 17-18, 2026. Our team evaluations are as relaxed as possible, and each evaluation will conclude with a short interview to go over athlete goals for the upcoming season.

Try-out Attire: T-shirt or sports bra, spunks or shorts and lightweight tennis shoes or cheer shoes with hair pulled into a ponytail with a bow. Athletes are assigned tryout numbers during evaluation. Evaluations will be held April 17-18, 2026. If you cannot make it on this day, you can tryout by appointment.

Evaluation Procedures:

- 1) Schedule an evaluation time beginning March 30, 2026 with the front desk by calling 281-741-0531 OR request an evaluation time in your parent portal under the CAMPS/EVENTS TAB. Parent Portal Link: <https://app.iclasspro.com/parentportal/odysseycheerco>
- 2) Thoroughly read through the 2026-2027 Cheer Contract Packet and program offerings/payment information sheets. All-star cheerleading is a SELECT sport and requires a large time and financial commitment. Please make sure you understand what you are committed to.
- 3) Turn in the 2026-2027 All-Star Registration Form, Parent & Athlete Rules Form and the Credit Card Authorization Form found in this evaluation packet. If this paperwork is not turned in your athlete will not be able to tryout.
- 4) New athletes - turn in a photo and copy of a birth certificate. Returning athletes - turn in a current photo.
- 5) If you are not a current member, a \$55 non-refundable registration fee per athlete will apply and will be charged to the card on file prior to tryouts.
- 6) Submit practice wear and practice bow payment on or before your evaluation time. \$200 plus tax for competitive and prep teams & \$100 plus tax for show team and novice. *Price is subject to increase pending final design.*

*Odyssey Cheer Company will always do what is best for a team to grow and have success throughout the season. **Athletes will be considered for teams based on age, level availability and level requirements AS WELL AS prior year commitment level and behavior.** Please note that athlete maturity, tumbling ability and jumping skills are also taken into consideration during team evaluations. Skills **MUST** be consistent and demonstrate **STRONG** technique in order drive the future success of a team. We are looking for well-rounded athletes with strong work ethic - simply having the necessary tumbling skills does not guarantee that a candidate will automatically make that level team.*

TEAM PLACEMENT & TRYOUT REQUIREMENTS

Team evaluations will take place April 17-18, 2026. Staff will place athletes into **team groups** and results will be posted on our website on May 15, 2026. We will have team group workouts May 17 – June 28, 2026. Placements are NOT final, and athletes may continue to be moved throughout those weeks. There will be no planned workouts June 29- July 5, 2026 (4th of July holiday) as we finalize teams. Our staff will select teams and notify athletes and parents of their final team placement, coaches, and practice days/times on June 29th, 2026.



Team members will be selected based upon individual skills, experience, and stunt position, ability to focus, commitment, and positive attitude. Athletes may be moved from one team to another and/or one position to another at any point during the season at OCC staff discretion based on skill development/retention of skills, attendance, injuries as well as specific team needs. Choreography dates July 25th – August 3rd.

Tryout Information: Skill Level Requirements

Tryouts at Odyssey Cheer Company will be held in a fun and relaxed environment. Our staff will guide athletes throughout the entire process, helping them feel comfortable and at ease. Each athlete will perform running and standing tumbling skills based on their ability level as well as jumps. They will also have a chance to demonstrate any additional tumbling skills they wish to perform beyond the coaches' request. Coaches will also be observing attitudes and personality.

Tumbling at Tryouts:

Athletes should review the tumbling skill requirements for each level to set their goals for tryouts. It is important to understand that strong teams are formed by athletes who can tumble, jump, stunt, and perform, while also having the mental maturity appropriate for their age and team level. MOST athletes placed on an Elite team will be expected to perform advanced and elite standing and running tumbling skills for their level with a high level of execution and consistency. Athletes trying out for novice and/or prep teams will be guided throughout the tryout process by OCC staff. The novice division is designed for younger and/or entry level athletes who may be new to cheerleading. Athletes will be asked to demonstrate what skills they are comfortable with, which may include cartwheels, round-offs, bridge kick-overs, and front and back walkovers. Prep level is intended for athletes who may be able to perform stronger front and back walk-overs, round-offs, cartwheel series, etc.

Flyers:

Athletes who want to be considered for a flyer position will have their body positions evaluated during the tryout either on the ground, on a stunt block, or with a coach. For those new to competitive cheerleading, strong flexibility and body control are essential to giving yourself the best opportunity to be selected as a flyer. Keep in mind that trying out as a flyer does not guarantee a flying position, and the same applies to a base or back spot position. NOTE: flyers must attend flyer classes or private lessons throughout the season.

Registration Fee: Non-refundable per athlete registration fee. This fee covers annual liability insurance fees.

Practice Wear and Bow: Competitive and prep teams will receive 2 practice wear sets & 2 bows. One set has a matching tank top that is optional. Novice and Show team will receive 1 practice wear set and bow.

Monthly Tuition: Monthly tuition is due on the 3rd of the month. **ALL ATHLETES MUST HAVE A CREDIT CARD ON FILE TO RECEIVE AUTOPAY TUITION RATE – NO EXCEPTIONS.** Tuition is drafted by the 3rd day of each month. If you want to use another payment method, payment must be received no later than the 2nd of each month. A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 5th day of each month. This will be strictly enforced this year. It is your responsibility to update lost/stolen CC information as well as billing/address changes. Monthly fees more than 25 days late will result in your athlete sitting out of practice. Odyssey Cheer offers a 10% discount on annual tuition paid in full before 6/1/26. Tuition is based on 11 months and split equally between all 11 months, it also covers all extra practices. We do not prorate tuition for holidays or gym closings.





TEAM EXPENSES CONTINUED

Team Fees: Team fees are due on the 16th of the month, each month from June through February (9 payments). A \$25 late fee per account will be assessed on the 17th day of each month. Team fees include the following items: competition entry fees, coach's event fees & travel, music, choreography, stunt clinic and in-house team camp.

- **Competitions:** Competitive teams will attend 6-10 events per season. Prep and Show team teams will attend 5-7 local events each season and Novice full year teams will attend 5 local competitions per season. All competition teams will attend a MANDATORY end of season out-of-state event (e.g., The Summit, The One, ASW) and prep teams will attend ONE MANDATORY end of season in-state event. **End of year competition fees and coaches cost to bid events will be paid separately.**
- **Music, Choreography and Team Camp:** Team choreography takes significant planning outside of regular practices. **Mandatory team choreography camps are scheduled for July 25th – August 3rd for Elite teams, Prep and Novice.**
- **Please make sure to plan any family vacations, summer camps or other activities around choreography camp days.** All athletes are required to attend camp (**no exceptions**). Note that no refunds are given in the event that an athlete cannot attend camp as they are still being included in the routine choreography. If you are absent for any reason, you must find an athlete to fill in from another team. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Uniform Bundles

- Competition uniforms (top & skirt) are the same as last season for Elite and Prep. Used uniforms may be available for purchase through the gym at the time of sizing.
- Novice teams will get new uniforms this season
- Practice Wear: All athletes will need to purchase NEW practice wear this season. Practice wear will cost \$100 per outfit plus tax, and includes top (sports bra), bottom (skirt or short) and bow. Competitive and prep teams will need to purchase two practice wear sets.
- Baseball Cover-Up: All competitive and prep athletes will need to have a baseball jersey cover-up. If your athlete purchased one in a previous season, they will not need to purchase one for the 2026-2027 season. Baseball cover-ups cost \$75 plus tax. Names can be added for an additional cost.
- Team T-Shirt: All novice & show athletes will need to purchase a team t-shirt cover-up, including returning athletes. Team t-shirt cover-ups cost \$25 plus tax. Returning athletes that have previously purchased a baseball jersey cover-up will not need to purchase a team t-shirt.
- Competition Shoes: All athletes will need to purchase competition shoes through the pro-shop. Prices vary per team. If shoes are needed prior to the order date, please see the front desk.
- Bling Backpack: All competitive, prep, show & novice athletes will need to have an official Odyssey Bling Backpack. If your athlete was on novice or prep team and purchased one last season or in previous season, they will not need to purchase one for the 2026-2027 season. All competitive athletes must have a Nfinity Royal Blue Bling Backpack. Cost includes a personalized name tag. Novice and show athletes can upgrade to the competitive back pack by seeing the front desk.





TEAM COMMITMENT

Cheerleading is a team sport and the absence of even one member can greatly impact the effectiveness of practice. Therefore, all practices and performances are considered mandatory. When an athlete misses practice, it impacts not only their own progress but also their stunt group and teammates.

- Elite teams will practice 5 hours a week (Monday-Sunday): Two 2-hour sessions of team practice and one 1-hour session for tumbling/strengthening. Additional tumbling/stunting classes will receive a 25% discount. **Flyers are required to be enrolled in mandatory flyer classes or private lessons.**
- Prep Teams will practice 3.5 hours a week (Monday-Thursday): One 2-hour session of team practice and 1 1/2 hours of team tumble/stunt practice. Additional tumbling/stunting classes will receive a 25% discount. **Flyers are required to be enrolled in mandatory flyer classes or private lessons.**
- Novice teams will practice 2 hours a week (Monday-Thursday). Athletes wanting to enroll in tumbling classes will receive a 25% monthly discount on tumbling tuition.
- Show team will practice 1.5 hours a week (Monday-Thursday). Athletes wanting to enroll in tumbling classes will receive a 25% monthly discount on tumbling tuition.
- Teams may add additional practice before competitions.



Attendance Policy

Athletes and parents are expected to effectively balance academic responsibilities, family commitments, and athletic participation throughout the cheer season without missing scheduled practices. Athletes should plan accordingly to complete schoolwork outside of designated practice times. Missed practices negatively impact the entire team, as stunts, formations, and tumbling sequences rely on full team participation and cannot be properly executed in the absence of any member.

Attendance at all practices is required. We expect full commitment and prioritize consistent participation from every athlete. Adhering to this policy helps minimize the need for additional or makeup practices. For athletes participating in school cheer or other sports, parents are required to provide their school schedule in advance, along with contact information for the school coach. Practice absences should not be used as a form of discipline, as cheerleading is a team sport that depends on every member's presence.

During the weeks leading up to show-offs, regional competitions, and the two weeks prior to national events, all practices are considered mandatory and designated as blackout dates. No absences will be permitted during these periods. Missing practice during blackout dates may result in not being permitted to compete in the competition or immediate and permanent removal from the team.

The only excused absences during the season are mandatory, graded school functions. All other activities—including part-time employment, social events, dances, concerts, banquets, travel, family gatherings, weddings, recitals, and school or church social functions—are considered unexcused.

Cheerleading is a team sport and requires everyone on the team to do their part. We understand that a quest for greatness is achieved with self-discipline and dedication. If you sign up for a school activity or sport, make sure it will not interfere with practices or competitions.



ABSENCE POLICY

Missed practices will be documented and you will need to complete an **Absentee Request Form** to inform us of any future absences. ALL ABSENCES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY EMAIL TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ABSENCE TO: info@odysseycheer.com and an approval or denial will be returned by email. By joining Odyssey Cheer Company you are committing to your team over other sports/activities. Please note that absences are NOT allowed two weeks leading up to any competition.

Absence Allowance: May 2026 – August 2060: (4) absences, September 2026 - May 2027: (2) absences

- Beginning January 2027, only one unexcused practice session will be allowed through the end of the season. In the case of severe illness, the day of an event, parents are expected to stay in contact with OCC staff and work with a doctor in order to make every attempt to help the child get better as soon as possible.
- During the competitive season, repetitive absences may result in an athlete being removed from essential roles to minimize the effect it has on the team. If an athlete's absence(s) begin to significantly affect their individual training, their stunt group's training or the overall progression of the team, the OCC coaching staff reserves the right to suspend or remove the athlete due to excessive absences.

Attendance during choreography is mandatory. If an athlete is absent for choreography, they will be removed from all main components of the routine. Choreography dates are **(July 25th – August 3rd)**.

ILLNESS: Athletes with fever, vomiting, or diarrhea are asked to not attend practice. If an athlete is "not feeling well", they are still expected to attend practice but sit out as needed to observe team activities.

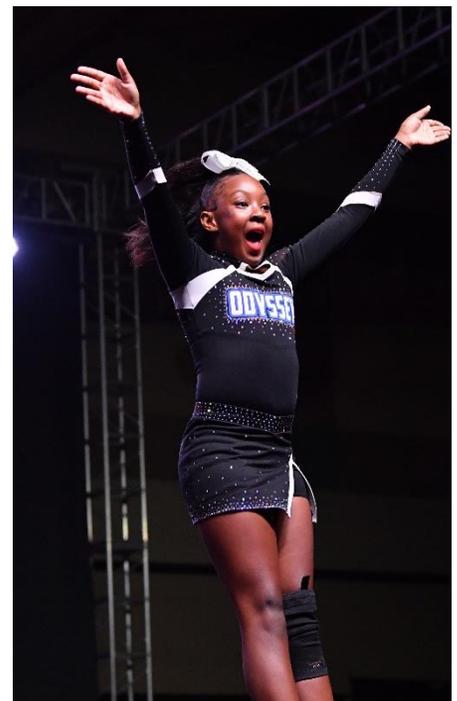
INJURY: If your athlete is injured and cannot practice more than one practice session, please make sure you have seen a doctor and have a note stating the injury and the recovery period. We will need a doctor's release for any injured athlete to participate in practice and/or competitions. Even if an athlete is released, **the athlete must be able to perform at the appropriate level to be incorporated back into the team practice. The athlete will be able to participate in practice/competition at the discretion of the coach.**

During the school year, no more than two unexcused practice sessions will be allowed. Beginning January 2027, only one unexcused practice session will be allowed through the end of the season. In the case of severe illness, the day of an event, parents are expected to stay in contact with OCC staff and work with a doctor in order to make every attempt to help the child get better as soon as possible.
